In line with the Minjerribah Camping COVID management plan, we regret to advise that guests aged 16 years and older who have not been fully vaccinated or cannot provide a COVID-19 digital certificate verifying they are fully vaccinated, can not be accepted.

All guests 16 years and older intending to stay with Minjerribah or Mulgumpin Camping **are required** to supply their vaccination certificate, no later than seven days prior to arrival.

Minjerribah Camping reserves the right to cancel a booking and provide a refund where proof of COVID vaccination(s) have not been produced seven days prior to arrival.

In the event your booking is cancelled, Minjerribah Camping will process a refund accordingly. Alternatively, you may elect to move your booking to a later date.
